- Regularly meet with Miss Mastroianni to demonstrate pro-life leadership in the school
- Work with Campus Ministry to improve Right to Life Tuesdays at Mount de Sales Academy, held every Tuesday after school. Fifteen to twenty students and faculty walk to the Hillcrest Abortion Clinic or gather in the chapel to pray for the unborn and their parents.
